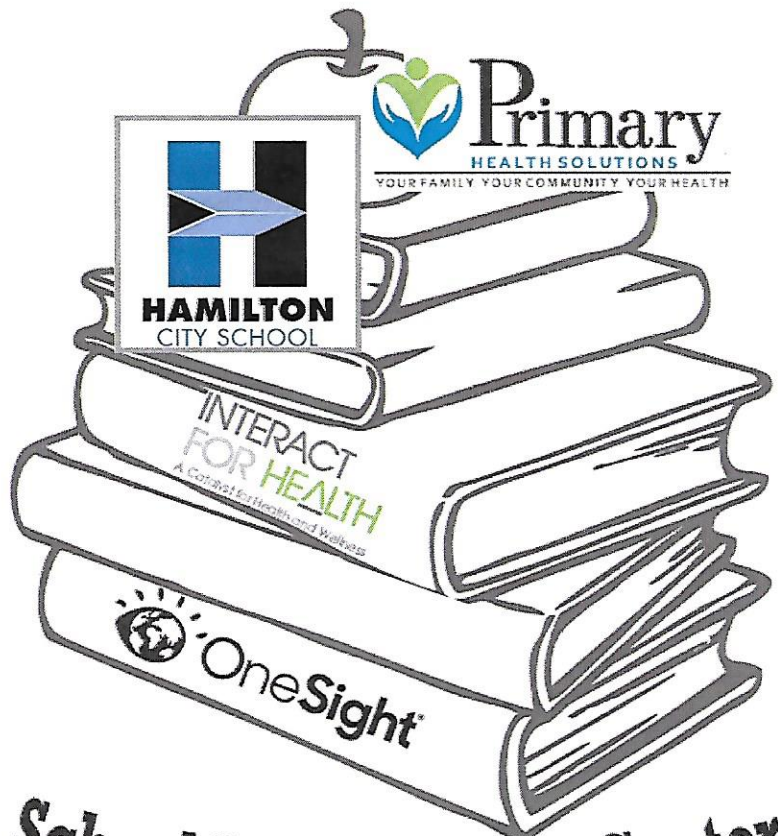

Hamilton City School District is partnering with Primary Health Solutions to provide a school-based health program with fully integrated care.

Primary Health Solutions, a Butler County based organization that operates Federally Qualified Health Centers, is partnering with the Hamilton City School District, OneSight and Interact for Health to provide access to primary medical, dental, vision and behavioral health services to students, their family members and school district staff.

The center will improve access to care for all children within the district, regardless of their insurance status. Center staff will be available to assist families with insurance enrollment, if uninsured.

School-based healthcare can serve students differently, based on need. Statistics show that teens are the least likely to get the recommended health services. Medical services include immunizations, sports/work/annual physicals, asthma or other chronic disease management and acute care for sick or injured students. Behavioral Health services will be based on unique client need. Vision services will include comprehensive eye examinations and the prescribing and dispensing of corrective lenses if necessary. Dental services, which will be provided by Primary Health Solutions Mobile Dental Van, will include preventative exams, cleanings, x-rays and corrective treatment as needed.

The purpose of the center is to keep students in school and ready to learn. Students will receive care during the school day, without requiring the parents to leave work and lose wages.
